Required Step for Today:

Fill in one copy of the reverse side and hand it in. Please note: Don't remove any materials from your pages yet.

Suggested Procedure:

1. Assign topics to each person on your team. That person will be responsible for writing the first draft of the paper on that topic. Remember to include responsibility for the introduction and conclusion. Post this information on your wiki by Friday morning (March 2). We recommend that you put the paper draft at the top of your wiki page, pushing all the other collected information to the bottom.
2. We strongly recommend that each person be responsible for writing their portion of the body of the paper by noon, **Sunday, March 4**. It might be a good idea to give each section under a boldface heading in which the writer explains what the section is and what it is trying to show. (This heading will come out of the final paper.) We are not big fans of the five paragraph essay, so take as many paragraphs as you feel you need. We also recommend that the people writing the introduction and conclusion wait to do so until after the first draft of the body of the paper is complete. The person responsible for the introduction should then write the introduction and finally the person responsible for the conclusion should write the conclusion. They should complete their part by noon, **Monday, March 5**.
3. After the body of the essay is in place (ideally by noon on March 4), all members of the group should be free to **add** material to it. After the introduction and conclusion are complete, members may also **add** material to them. These additions could take the form of additional text or questions (we recommend that anything you don't want added to the text be marked in boldface. Don't use square brackets!! The wiki technology will see that as a command to create another wiki page.) We'll give you time in class on Tuesday to talk about any conflicts that have appeared in your wiki and transitions between parts of the essay. We will also make some suggestions about editing the final product.
